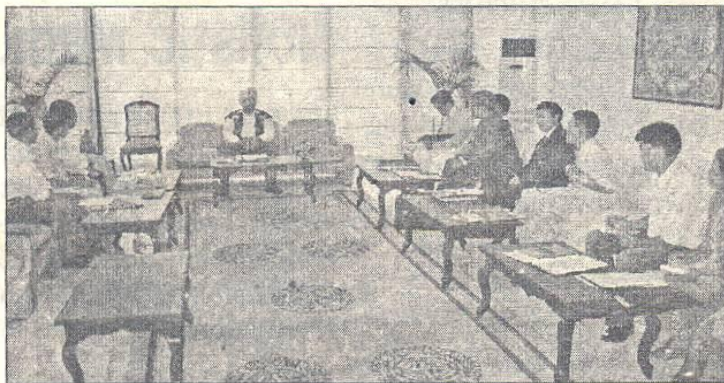


Welfare of the ex-servicemen on priority list: Governor Singh

The Governor also hoped that all the Ex-Servicemen will serve as role model for the citizens of Arunachal Pradesh and will take up various pilot projects under organic farming, medicinal plants, bee keeping.

He also expressed hope that all gallantry awardees of the state should be honoured and suitable cash award be provided to them.

Kendriya Sainik Board Secretary Commodore K C Choudhury announced that 73 lakhs has been released to Arunachal Pradesh as Central share for establishment of Rajya Sainik Board/Zila Sainik Board.

He further assured that all benefits like financial assistance for house repairs should be provided to ex-servicemen through Director Relief, Rehabilitation and Disaster Management.

Special invitee Col B Deshmukh, Director of Sainik Welfare Board Maharashtra also participated in the meeting. He shared his experience with success stories of the welfare activities of ex-servicemen taken up in Maharashtra which can be applicable to Arunachal Pradesh.
