Governor visits Eastern Air Command

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM,UYSM, YSM (Retd.) visited Headquarters Eastern Air Command, Shillong on 4th June 2026 and had a detailed deliberations with Air Officer Commanding-in-Chief of the Eastern Air Command of the Indian Air Force, Shillong, Air Marshal Inderpal Singh Walia, AVSM, VSM. The Governor, who is in Shillong for the Plenary Session of the North Eastern Council (NEC), held a cordial interaction with the Air Marshal on matters concerning air connectivity, border infrastructure, disaster response, and the welfare of the people of Arunachal Pradesh.

During the meeting, the Governor expressed his deep appreciation for the significant contribution of the Eastern Air Command in serving the people of Arunachal Pradesh, especially those living in remote and inaccessible areas. He commended the Indian Air Force for its vital role in ration-dropping operations, airlifting essential supplies, evacuating patients during medical emergencies, and providing timely assistance during natural disasters and other urgent situations. He noted that such support has often been a lifeline for communities facing connectivity challenges due to the State's difficult terrain.

Emphasizing the strategic importance of Arunachal Pradesh, the Governor underscored the need to further strengthen the network of Advance Landing Grounds (ALGs) across the State. He observed that well-maintained ALGs are essential for national security, disaster response, improved connectivity, and the development of border areas.

The Governor also appreciated the initiative of organizing the Inter-Advance Landing Ground Football Tournament, describing it as an effective platform for fostering goodwill and strengthening bonds between Air Warriors and local communities. He expressed happiness over the enthusiastic participation of local youth and hoped that similar sporting events in other disciplines would be organized regularly to encourage talent and promote community engagement.

AOC-in-C assured the Governor of the Indian Air Force's continued support to the people of Arunachal Pradesh and reaffirmed the Eastern Air Command's commitment to humanitarian assistance, emergency response, connectivity, and national security.
